



Network Account Management v10.4 Exam Sample Test

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The Network Account Management v10.4 Exam (Prometric exam no. 9L0-615) is a computer-based test offered at Authorized Prometric Testing Centers.

The exam is one of several elective exams in the Apple Certified System Administrator (ACSA) track. If you pass this exam you earn Network Account Management 10.4 certification as well as 3 credits toward ACSA certification.

This Sample Test presents ten test questions similar in style and content to those presented in the actual Network Account Management v10.4 Exam. Reviewing these questions can familiarize you with the type of questions posed in the actual exam. Actual questions on the exam will vary in content and may be more or less difficult than these.

Sample Questions

1. You have set a default home page for one of your workgroups, and managed this setting to apply Often. What is the effect of this setting on a user who logs in as a member of this workgroup?
 - A. Each time a user logs in, this home page setting will be implemented; the user can never change the default home page.
 - B. When a user first logs in, this home page setting will be implemented; the user can permanently change the default home page at any time.
 - C. Each time a user logs in, this home page setting will be implemented; the user can change the default home page for the duration of the login session.
 - D. Each time a user logs in, this home page setting will be implemented; the user can only change the default homepage by logging in to another workgroup.

2. Which statement defines a preference manifest best?

9. How does the Apple Remote Desktop (ARD) package installation feature work?

 - C. ARD copies the package(s) to the target computer, then launches the Installer. The user interacts with the Installer to determine which packages to install.
 - D. ARD identifies the best time for the Installer to run on the target computer by reviewing the task server logs. If the target computer is offline, ARD will prompt the next user who logs in to run the Installer.
10. You want to use Remote Desktop to send one command that sets several computers to start up from a specific local volume. What must be true for this to be possible?
- A. The startup volume must be an internal hard drive.
 - B. The boot volume's name must be identical on all the client computers.
 - C. You must have Shut Down and Restart privileges on each of the client computers.
 - D. The client computers must be on the same subnet as the Remote Desktop admin computer.
