The exam is one of several elective exams in the Apple Certified System Administrator (ACSA) track. If you pass this exam you earn Podcast and Streamed Internet Media Administration certification as well as 3 credits toward ACSA certification.

Reviewing these questions can familiarize you with the type of questions posed in the actual exam. Actual questions on the exam will vary in content and may be more or less difficult than these.
